As all proposal have more than 66% of the votes in favour of YES, according to the FISLY statutes all proposals are accepted by the electronic FISLY Extraordinary General Assembly :

7.8 Decisions on the annual Assembly or on the extraordinary General Assembly on dissolution and destination of FISLY assets require three fourths of the actual votes (abstentions not included). Amendments to the statutes and to the regulations are decided upon by two thirds majority of the actual votes of the members with a right to vote. Other matters are decided upon by simple majority of votes.

7.9 Written decision making (or faxed or e-mailed) by the General Assembly is allowed. In case of written ballots by the members with a voting right the following majorities prevail:

Dissolution: 3/4 of all votes

Any other decision: 2/3 of all votes

According to the decision of the FISLY council of the 16th and 17th of February 2019, these rule changes will be valid from the 1st of June 2019.
