France

Cancelled

Class 8 at MARCK EN CALAISIS from the 8th to the 12th of September 2020

We received a letter in French on the annulation of this event and the proposal to postpone from the 31st to the 4th of September 2021.

Classes 2,3, 5 and STANDART at CAMIERS from the 3rd to the 9th of October 2020

Due to the corona the organisers do not to let it take place in 2020. The proposal is to postpone to 25/09 until 01/10/2021.

The candidateship of the clubs for organising the championships in France in 2021 will have to be reopened in the FFCV.FISLY agrees to postpone and to give the mandate to France for 2021. FISLY would prefer that the same organisers can produce the championships in respect for the preparations that already have been done.

There is no official news from France. The postponement has been announced on Facebook. There is an agreement that the same clubs will organise the championships in France in 2021.

So there will be no championships in 2020.

- 2022 : Argentina : World championships

A championship can be organised in Barreal, Province San Juan. There is support from the local authorities.

Barreal is known for landsailing since the 1970ies when Johan Byttebier introduced landsailing. In 1980 races were organised sponsored by Marlboro. The advertisements were seen in the USA. At some of these events 200 people were present.

2 years ago a championship was organised with 70 participants.

For this championship the proposal would be to organise it also for Blokart.

Containers can best be sent to Chile, Santiago or Valparaiso. These are the closest ports to the lake.

The organisation will be a joint venture of Argentina and Chile.

- 2023 : Belgium ?
2023 : UK for Mini Yachts at Lytham-St. Annes
Actual status : Mark Sereiko insists on having a championships for MY in Lytham as he asked for it for a number of years. It is important for the future of landsailing in the UK.
In Belgium there is not the possibility to organise at the same time a Class 8 championship. Could it be organised by PKA at the Wirral ?
- 2024 : UK – all possible classes
2024 : Belgium : eventually other classes.
- 2025 : Germany ?
- 2026 : Netherlands ? Also World Championships ?
- 2027 : Belgium ?
- 2028 : France ?
- 2029 : UK ?
- 2030 : Argentina, World championship in Rada Tilly.

4. Racing programs :

- International races :
As there are no championships in 2020 the club in Asnelles asked to organise a European Challenge for Standart and for Blokart that is open for non-Europeans. It is important that the FFCV agrees with this project.
This project has been cancelled.
- The Potjesregatta will be organised on the 19, 20 and 21 of September. As there are no a championships this year this event will be entitled to be European Trophy.
There will be races for 2,3,5 and Standart.

5. Classes:

Blokart pilots show interest in becoming member of FISLY. Therefor we need an worldwide Blokart association. Argentina has 20 Blokart pilots and could propose to launch this association.
